Chair Campbell called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

**Consider minutes of the March 21, 2016 and April 11, 2016 meetings**

The minutes of the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission meetings held on March 21, 2016, were presented for approval. **Mr. King made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Lindsey. The motion passed.** The minutes of the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission meeting April 11, 2016 were **approved by motion of Mr. Lindsey, seconded by Mr. King. The motion passed.**

**Election of Officers for the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission**

Mr. Campbell stated that the April 11<sup>th</sup> meeting was last for Vice Chair Irene Pitts-McDonald and the commission would like to recognize her for service rendered to the City of Murfreesboro and the Cable Television Commission. Mr. Bozeman stated that Mr. Doug Cook is present and has been appointed by the Mayor and City Council and welcomed him to the commission. Both seats of chair and vice chair for the commission need to be filled. The nominations will be followed by a roll call vote for each position. Mr. Patterson and Mr. Hienrich nominated Tommy Campbell for Chair. **After the roll call vote, the Commission unanimously voted that Tommy Campbell remain the Chair for the Commission.** Mr. Shacklett and Mr. Hienrich nominated Brian Patterson for Vice Chair. **After the roll call vote, the Commission voted Brian Patterson as Vice Chair. Mr. Patterson abstained from the vote.**

**Consider a request from the League of Women voters of Murfreesboro and Rutherford County** Mr. Bozeman stated that the Communication Department is sponsoring again this year to cover the City Council and City School Board candidate forums. This will be presented by

the League of Women Voters of Murfreesboro and Rutherford County. The date is July 18<sup>th</sup> in the Council Chambers. The broadcast will be covered on City TV and also streamed live on the City's website. It will be replayed and archived on the City's website. The Council Chambers renovations will be completed before the forum. Mr. Patterson asked if there is a cost associated with the production. Mr. Bozeman said only normal labor hours and would be incorporated into the weekly work schedule as this event is one of the main goals of covering on the channel. Mr. Patterson asked if there will be a forum for the council with 3 candidates. Ms. Collum said yes. Mr. Patterson asked how the forum would be marketed. Ms. Collum said it would be advertised on City TV, MTSU, and in the Daily News Journal. Mr. Hienrich asked who has moderated in the past. Ms. Collum said it is usually a professor and the LWV gather 10 to 20 questions and send to the moderator. The moderator will pick 5 or 6 questions to ask. Mr. King asked if there is a backup plan if the Council Chambers are not completed. Mr. Bozeman state that he is confident that construction will be complete before the forum. **Mr. Patterson made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. King. The motion passed.**

### **Staff Reports/Comments**

Mr. Bozeman said included with the package are the latest Comcast Cable issues received since the last meeting. Most of the issues have been resolved. There was information included in the packet highlighting Xfinity TV programming on the new Samsung Smart TV's including an app to receive channels without the need to have a box. Ms. Hayden stated that this program that is just being launched by Comcast. They are hoping to get more information out to let customers know when and where it will available. The company is finding ways they can be in homes in an easier way. Mr. Campbell asked if the only difference is the absence of the box. Ms. Hayden said there has to be a Comcast account that could be logged into via the app. Once more information becomes available they will share. Mr. Campbell asked if the digital adapter would be eliminated. Ms. Hayden said yes. Mr. Lindsey asked how the TV would access the internet. Ms. Hayden said it would be connected the same as a computer or mobile phones. Mr. Campbell asked if other brands would have the capability as well. Ms. Hayden stated she assumes there will be more manufacturers will eventually have the same options.

Mr. Bozeman said the Commission should have a franchise fee settlement agreement to review at the next meeting.

The renovations in the Council Chambers and the Communications Department production area is going as scheduled and should be completed on time. After completion of the first phase of renovation construction, the new a/v system will be installed and once that is completed then phase 2 renovation construction will begin. The renovations are being done in phases so the channel can continue to function why the new a/v system is being installed. All work should be completed at the end of October.

Mr. Campbell asked if the Parks & Recreation Department has made application to have the fireworks show on Comcast. Mr. Bozeman said they do not have a way to telecast live but it could be recorded. Mr. Campbell stated that he appreciated all the commission members for

their work. Mr. Shacklett stated that he would like for Mr. Cook to inform the commission of his background. Mr. Cook stated that he has been involved in the planning of the half time Super Bowl shows, CMA's, and other shows all over the world. A lot of his work is with live television and has done events and concerts for the past 20 years. He is originally from Florida and his wife his from here and moved here after their children was born.

There being no other business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned **by motion of Mr. Lindsey, seconded by Mr. Hienrich. The motion passed.**

Chair Campbell called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

**Consider a settlement agreement regarding Comcast franchise fee review**

Mr. Bozeman stated this process started during the last budget year by hiring Mr. Dick Treich with Front Range Consulting to look at the Comcast Franchise fee payments being received from 2012 to 2014. Mr. Treich has finished his review. There is a negotiated settlement agreement before the commission for review and approval. The agreement includes underpayments of just under \$12,000 and Comcast plans to correct some of the problems that Mr. Treich found going forward. Mr. Treich is on the conference call to explain the findings.

Mr. Treich stated that his last conversation with the commission was a situation where Comcast could not provide the billing system information needed to review the bundle packages that include voice, video, and data. The video is the portion of the data needed to review as part of the bundled package. They were not able to provide the information during the initial review. Since that point in time, they found a way to get the data. In doing so, they produced some billing reports that had in excess of 100 packages in each year that had at least with the video either a voice or data product. Comcast showed the allocation and how it was allocated. In virtually every case, the allocations were incorrect. Some were over allocated to video and some were under allocated to video. It was a hodge podge of what was included in the packages. The net result was that they went back and recalculated it and resulted in the almost \$12,000 in net underpayments. There are some disagreements that he still has with the way Comcast came up with the calculations. It is not worth arguing because it would result in taking them to court to collect a small amount of underpayments. 90 percent of the errors have been corrected. In this settlement agreement, the most important portion is in paragraph with the amount of \$11,967.93. Paragraph B talks about the requirement of allocations on a proportional basis in accordance with GAAP. The exception is in the 5<sup>th</sup> line dealing with the sales tax. Certain items in the bundle may not be subject to discount for tax or other legal or regulatory reasons. Sales tax does not allow for discount equipment leased. Comcast will fix this within 6 months, which is good news going forward. At the end of the year there will

be a good proportional base allocation in paragraph B. They have also agreed that they will update the allocation each time a rate card each time package prices are changed. Going forward from 2017 the franchise fee will be done correctly. It is a positive settlement with paragraph 1B being critical.

Mr. Campbell asked if the settlement is based on 2012 to 2014. Mr. Treich said yes. Mr. Campbell asked if 2015 and 2016 are left unaddressed unless the commission would like to have another review. Mr. Treich said that is correct. Mr. Campbell asked if it is recommended to have another review. Mr. Treich said his initial thought is that more money would be required than would be received. This means that the funds that would go toward the review would be greater than the funds received. The most important thing is that Comcast will fix the errors he found. Mr. Campbell asked if there is any impact on the customer. Mr. Treich stated there could be a slight impact to the customer because Comcast is reserving their rights in paragraph 1A to pass through the underpayments outlined in the settlement if they choose. Mr. Bozeman stated that this is standard language used in the previous franchise fee settlements. Mr. Patterson asked if this fee would be passed along to the customers. Ms. Hayden said she did not know, but the legal language is very important to the company because they reserve the right.

Mr. Patterson asked if this is approved, would Comcast have to document that it was not collected on the front end. Mr. Treich said no, there is no federal law that requires the city to get anything but what is already received with the franchise fee payments. Mr. King asked if this fee would be going forward or would Comcast go back to gather from past subscribers. Mr. Treich said they can't go back, but would be prospective and start in January 2017 annual rate increase.

Mr. Patterson asked if this item were deferred, could the commission find what the intentions of Comcast are as to whether or not they are going to pass through the underpayment to subscribers. Mr. Bozeman said that question was asked during the agreement process and they would not give a comment one way or another. Ms. Baker said that discussion has already been exhausted with Comcast. Mr. King asked what date would the 6-month timeframe begin for the error to be fixed, and what happens if they do not meet the 6-month window. Mr. Treich said that would be a franchise violation. In paragraph 4B has language regarding breach of the agreement. Ms. Hayden stated that they switched billing systems in November of 2015 and they believe that almost all of the issues have been fixed based on that information. They have asked for 6 months so that they can double and triple check. She does anticipate the corrections are complete before the 6-month deadline. Mr. Treich said he has been in review of 2014 and 2015 with the new CSG systems and they are not at all being correctly being pro rata at allocations. He is unsure whether that is correct or not. A new billing system would not go back and process reallocations. He said he could be wrong. Ms. Hayden said based on talking with the bill reviewers, that information was received to pass along to the commission. Mr. King asked how will the commission know the fix has been and made correction. Mr. Treich said there is no mechanism to guarantee that other than doing another franchise fee review.

Mr. Campbell stated that staff and the consultant has completed their due diligence with the settlement and is unsure that delaying it would do anything other than delaying it further. Mr. Patterson asked if there would be another review at the end of 2017. Mr. Bozeman said generally the City Council approves funding about every 7 to 10 years for franchise fee reviews. Mr. King asked how often does Comcast pay their franchise fee. Mr. Bozeman said it is paid quarterly. Mr. King said if they are doing it correctly, the commission can assume to get a certain dollar amount knowing the number of subscribers and the average invoice. The amount would be very close to what should be received in each quarter. Mr. Treich said the problem with that is over time, with the bundle the video goes up because of the rates are raised. The average revenue is video revenue and not something that is constant and could change on average one dollar or two a year. That would be a tremendous fluctuation with 25,000 subscribers. Once Comcast has informed the commission that the system has been fixed, there could be a request for them to show the report and call it a franchise fee review. It would not be for 2012-2014 but a limited review for 2015-2016. Mr. Patterson said he likes that option, and the commission should make it a point to check back. Mr. Bozeman said the agreement expires in 2018, and that could be a negotiation points. **Mr. Patterson made a motion to accept the settlement agreement, seconded by Mr. Hienrich. The motion passed.**


#### **Staff Reports/Comments**

City Manager Rob Lyons recommends that the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission consider a request for the Communications Department to cover the Tennessee Journalism Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony.

The Tennessee Journalism Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will occur on December 8, 2016 in Murfreesboro. This Ceremony, if approved for coverage, will be recorded and cablecast later on CityTV.

The procedure for such a request, which is stated in the CityTV Programming Policy and Procedures under section E. Program Sources section, is as follows:

6. Outside Source Programs Requiring Video Production - Some municipal access channel programs will come from sources outside the City and require video production. Such programming will be integrated into the overall public information purposes of the municipal access channel, and must have prior approval by the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission and meet the following criteria:
  - a. Must fit within the objectives of the municipal access channel.
  - b. Is sponsored in writing by the City Manager or a city department head.
  - c. Programs/productions by non-government agencies/entities shall sign an Indemnification/Hold Harmless form.

One of the purposes of the channel, which this request falls under, is:

3. *To promote the education of citizens by presenting educational and cultural programs beneficial to the City's citizens.*

The organization has signed the Indemnification/Hold Harmless Agreement form to protect the City from any issues that could arise from recording, cablecasting, and webstreaming this outside event.

In light of the above, staff recommends approval of this request to record and cablecast on CityTV the Tennessee Journalism Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony, subject to staff availability.

It has been estimated that labor costs for covering this outside event would currently run around:

- \$450 to prepare, set up, and record
- \$600 to edit/prepare for cablecast and webstream
- Totaling \$1050 for the production (this does not include equipment related costs)

Indemnify and hold harmless the City of Murfreesboro, its employees, agents and representatives, of and from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, including costs and reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of any claim that any material cablecast or disseminated on the program infringes or violates any of the representations set forth above and any federal, state and/or local law, and any rights of any person or organization. Indemnify and hold harmless and defend the City, its employees, agents, and representatives, in any claim or lawsuit that may be made or filed, which arises from the use of any copyrighted material, whether said copyright is implied or actual.
5. These representations shall survive the initial broadcast program.
6. If signing on behalf of organization, I am authorized to bind such organization.


