Chair Campbell called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

Consider minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting

The minutes of the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission meeting held on February 8, 2016, were presented for approval. Mr. Lindsey **made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Hienrich. The motion passed.**

Pursuant to Order 98-03, conduct a public hearing to evaluate MTSU’s use of both educational access channels as they relate to the public good, signal quality and other relevant factors. Mr. Bozeman said prior to 1998 Middle Tennessee State University was utilizing one of the educational access channels on the cable system at that time. Then in 1998 they requested that the second educational access channel be turned over to them for programming the second educational access channels on the cable system. One is for the student channel and the other for educational resource. The City agreed in return that there would be an annual public hearing to evaluate the use of both channels for the public good, signal quality and other relevant factors. Included with the agenda package is the notice for both channels about the meeting and criteria for review.

Chair Campbell opened the public hearing.

Channel 9

Mr. Whitaker reported that the channel is in HD and would hope Comcast would someday carry them in HD.

Mr. Whitaker said the Center for Educational Media produced 179 television programs. The MTSU Out of the Blue program was co-produced with the Marketing and Communications office. Tennessee Teachers Talk is a K-12 professional development program for teachers. A lot of the shows are distributed through PEG media and TelVue Media Connect. There are 204 licensed

programs from different distributors, independent producers and production companies totaling 93 hours. This is also part of the sharing aspects with 762 free professionally produced programs. They find the best programs and keep in touch with distributors, seek local and nationwide producers. On Channel 9, programming is produced 12 months out of the year. Channel 9 partners with the School of Behavioral Science on a series of shows promoting students in all grades and producing the Tennessee Board of Regents Grant Base Documentary. Work is continuing with the non-profit Jason Foundation for teen suicide prevention and information. They have begun work with the County Music Hall of Fame with their K-12 professional development. The second initiative with MTSU is the ongoing commitment to improving access to all individuals under the ADA by providing closed captioning. They are still committed to providing the programming information on an electronic programming guide to the residents of Rutherford County who receive their signal. The station is continually monitored by seven offices, and by key personnel. In the production room the return from Comcast is monitored periodically during the day as well as the fiber optic line delivering the signal. In the event of any lost signal, the video production manager is alerted and the assistant engineer work directly with Comcast service to resolve the problem. During the evening, staff can access the server through remote desk top access to resolve problems.

Ms. Clark said the closed captioning work is being looked at closely with the University Committee and Ty has done research on the university's approach. Ty has taken that information to see how it can be done on a small scale. Mr. Campbell asked what is expected progress with closed captioning. Mr. Whitaker said he hopes to have 20% of programming by the end of the year. Mr. Lindsey asked if the captioning is processed by a video file. Mr. Whitaker said there are a couple of ways that it can be done. The live shows would be processed through engineering and the video files would be sent to Comcast to be decoded. Mr. King asked if there is any feedback on the teacher development channel. Mr. Whitaker said yes, it is used for continuing licensure and a survey is filled out. Ms. Clark said they ask teachers before the programming goes to production to seek feedback on what they need to hear. Mr. King asked if districts are monitored. Ms. Clark said they can monitor and receive reports by districts. She is currently reviewing all 200 plus videos for evaluation for its current relevance.

Channel 10

Mr. Billy Pittard, Department Chair of Electronic Communications where MT10 was originated provided an introduction. The name will be changed this summer to Media Arts. Ms. Katie Inman, News Director for MT10 was introduced. She oversees all the news operations for the general manager. The news is a big part of what MT10 does and is a student organization run 100% by students, but faculty advised. MT10 is HD ready and all shows are produced in HD. The programming produced varies with one show being The Rise and is in regular morning talk show in production that features live music and performers. A newer show is Indy Woods, is broadcast live from the outdoors with a mixture of nature and music. Ms. Inman said there were over 30 AP nominations this past weekend at the Associated Press awards, the channel received 12 first place awards. Mr. Pittard added that they have live television productions called MT Productions that have extracurricular production shows for sports that are aired on MT10, which is another source of content. There is about 50 hours of productions of new content this year. The Murfreesboro Christmas Parade was aired by a graduate of the program and MT10 was the single biggest factor inspiring his career. He now owns eight television production trucks that travel all over the country producing all sorts of events.

Ms. Inman stated that they produced a Vote 2016 show in the fall that covered local elections as well as elections throughout the whole state. The Presidential Election was also covered live till 2:00 a.m. The Vote 2016 special won an award this past weekend at the AP Awards. Mr. Pittard

said the live productions go into the student's portfolio for their personal career after they graduate. They have staff engineers that keep the channel going always and they also handle any trouble that may happen during the day. They are considering offering closed captioning and would like to purchase an encoder this summer to enhance the news room automation.

Mr. Lindsey asked how many students are involved with programming. Mr. Pittard said there are typically about 30 students involved with the news broadcast and overall there are about 100 students involved in the entire program at any given time. Mr. King stated that the live events are fantastic for MTSU students and the City of Murfreesboro. The Murfreesboro Half Marathon would be a great event to cover that is promoting Murfreesboro or high school football show with 4 big schools in the city that would be a great interest. The voting process could also be made a big event by a live broadcast of the election votes being counted and announce. Ms. Clark stated that there is already a campus initiative and they could partner in doing live productions.

There being no further comments or questions, the public hearing was closed. Mr. Hienrich disclosed that he is a member of the MTSU community. **Mr. Lindsey motion to continue to allow both Comcast Channels 9 and 10 be programmed by MTSU for another year, seconded by Mr. Hienrich. The motion passed.**

Hear from Multi Media Producer Steve Burris regarding CityTV productions

Mr. Steve Burris he has produced the longest running show on CityTV called In The City. He covers a lot of ribbon cuttings and ground breakings. Most recently, he covered the groundbreaking of Police Headquarters and the naming of the Doug Young Public Safety Training Facility. Mr. Burris added that he also covers the annual Polar Bear Plunge. He also covers road projects with the city, TDOT, and Murfreesboro 2035 Plan focusing on development of the city. Historic Bottoms and Highland Avenue studies have both stemmed from the 2035 Plan and those are covered in the same manner, as well as the West Park input meeting. Board of Zoning Appeals and Historic Zoning Commission are covered by him as well. The main production is In the City, which is a 30-minute news program with 5 to 10 news stories hosted by Ceilia Herrell who is an MTSU graduate that works part time as a video journalist for the department.

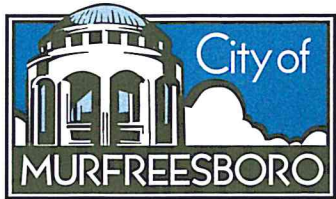
Ms. Herrell said that she has been with the city since October 2015 and was a member of MT10 from her freshman year to senior year at MTSU. Ms. Herrell added that she shoots, edits, and writes her own material. She runs the robotic cameras for all nightly meetings gaining technical knowledge. Mr. Burris added that he is currently working on a number of informational and/or promotional videos on emergency preparedness, McFadden Community Center, and Patterson Park Community Center. Mr. Campbell said that Channel 9, 10, and CityTV all have very impressive programming.

Mr. Bozeman provided the Commission with the most recently resolved Comcast cable television issues submitted to the Department from subscribers.

There being no other business to come before the Commission, Chair Campbell declared the meeting adjourned.

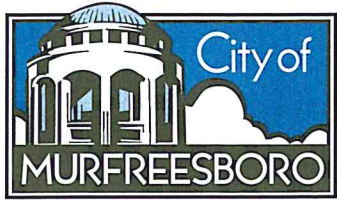
