Murfreesboro CityTV Wins National Awards

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. - Murfreesboro's Communications Department, home to Murfreesboro CityTV, received three national awards during the 28th annual Government Television Programming Awards presented by the National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors (NATOA).

The city's television programming can be viewed on Comcast cable channel 3, AT&T's U-Verse channel 99, YouTube, and the city website.

The winners were announced during a gala event on September 19 in Orlando, FL.

Murfreesboro CityTV brought home a second place award for "Excellence in Local Government Television Programming" which was judged on the agency's variety of programming quality throughout the year.

Honorable mentions were received for Mayor Bragg's State of the City and a public service announcement about CityTV on YouTube.
