Urban Environmental Employee becomes Certified Arborist

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. – On Oct. 19, 2013 Kane L. Adams with the City of Murfreesboro Urban Environmental Department demonstrated professional competency by successfully completing the Certified Arborist examination administered through the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) and the local Chapter of the ISA.

“I am very proud of Kane receiving this certification,” commented Urban Environmental Director Cynthia Holloway. “It shows his commitment to further enhance his high degree of knowledge about helping to care for and maintain the city’s urban forest. His new credentials reflect the professional skills sought by this department and will help aid him with others in the public and private sectors that involve themselves with many different types of landscape projects.”

The Purpose of the ISA Certification Program is to improve the level of knowledge and standard of practice within the tree care profession. It is designed to assist the public in identifying those professionals in arboriculture who have demonstrated, through a professionally developed examination and education program, a thorough knowledge of tree care practices. Certification affords the public and those in government the opportunity to make an informed selection of services based on the knowledge and advanced training demonstrated by an ISA Certification.

The International Society of Arboriculture is a scientific and educational organization devoted to the dissemination of information in the care and preservation of shade and ornamental trees.
