Murfreesboro 2035 Community Meeting, Tuesday, January 27

The City Murfreesboro will conduct a third public meeting to gather input from the community as part of the *Murfreesboro 2035* comprehensive plan. A community presentation on Chapter 2, Growth, will also be delivered by consultants from Kendig Keast Collaborative.

What: Residents, business owners, and community leaders will gather to provide input into Murfreesboro's quality of life, community character, and growth capacity. The community workshop is part of the ongoing process of developing a comprehensive plan for the City of Murfreesboro called ***Murfreesboro 2035: Our Future Begins Now.***
