***Murfreesboro 2035* Task Force Meeting, Wednesday, June 17**

The *Murfreesboro 2035* Task Force gathers June 17 to hear a presentation from consultant Kendig Keast Collaborative (KKC) on *Parks and Natural Resources* as part of the process to develop a 20-year comprehensive plan.

Who: The *Murfreesboro 2035* Task Force, a committee of a broad-section of the community, including business owners, community leaders and citizens.

What: The Task Force will gather to hear a presentation from consultant Kendig Keast Collaborative (KKC) on draft Chapter 6, *Parks and Natural Resources*, as it relates to Murfreesboro's quality of life, community character, and growth capacity. The Task Force is part of the 2-year process of developing a comprehensive plan for the City of Murfreesboro called ***Murfreesboro 2035: Our Future Begins Now.***

KKC will also present a critique of the land development code to the Planning Commission at the regular scheduled meeting, Wednesday, June 17, 2015 at 1 p.m., and a mid-point briefing of the comprehensive plan process to the City Council, Thursday, June 18, 2015, beginning at 5 p.m.

Murfreesboro 2035 is a community-wide process to plan for the next 20 years of growth and development. The final results of the two-year planning process is the City of Murfreesboro's Comprehensive Plan, a community guidebook that specifies policy, program, and project initiatives for the City. KKC is also preparing to submit drafts on *draft Chapter 4, Land Use* and *draft Chapter 3, Mobility.*
