MURFREESBORO, Tenn. - The Murfreesboro Water and Sewer Department (MWSD) 2014 Annual Water Quality Report is available for viewing online on the City of Murfreesboro website. Murfreesboro drinking water meets or exceeds all federal and state requirements.
