The State of the City reports on the following topics and more:

- For the 17th consecutive year, there will be no property tax increase.
- The new \$37 million Police Headquarters on Highland Avenue.
- Construction of the Stones River Greenway extension to Barfield Crescent Park.
- Groundbreaking for a new Class-A office building on Medical Center Parkway.
- Studying tax increment financing districts to encourage re-development.
- Attracting tournaments to the new \$5.8 million Adams Indoor Tennis Complex.
- Converting CityTV to High Definition (HD) through a grant from Comcast.
- Constructing a new headquarters for Rover, which continues to see increased ridership.
- Utilizing an online community discussion board similar to Mind Mixer to engage citizens.
- Continuing the popular Citizen Academies to invite citizens to learn more about the City.
