## Murfreesboro 2035 Task Force Meeting, Wednesday, Sept. 2

The *Murfreesboro 2035* Task Force gathers Wednesday, Sept. 2, 2015, to hear a presentation from consultant Kendig Keast Collaborative (KKC) on draft Chapter 4 *Land Use and Character* as part of the process to develop a 20-year comprehensive plan. KCC will also make separate presentations to the Planning Commission and City Council.

**Who**: The *Murfreesboro 2035* Task Force, a committee of a broad-section of the

community, including business owners, community leaders and citizens.

**What**: The Task Force will gather to hear a presentation from consultant Kendig Keast

Collaborative (KKC) on draft Chapter 4, *Land Use & Character*, as it relates to Murfreesboro's quality of life, community character, and growth capacity. The Task Force is part of the 2-year process of developing a comprehensive plan for the City of Murfreesboro called *Murfreesboro 2035*: Our Future Begins Now.

KKC will also present an update on the *Murfreesboro 2035* plan to the **Planning Commission** at the regular scheduled meeting, Wednesday, **September 2**, 2015 at 7 p.m., and a discussion of Priorities Guiding the *Murfreesboro 2035* Plan to the **City Council**, Thursday, **September 3**, 2015, at 5:30 p.m. Subconsultant Neel-Shaffer, Inc. continues to analyze traffic, growth, and future land use in preparation for the Major Thoroughfare Plan to be presented in Fall 2015.

*Murfreesboro 2035* is a community-wide process to plan for the next 20 years of growth and development. The final results of the two-year planning process is the City of Murfreesboro's Comprehensive Plan, a community guidebook that specifies policy, program, and project initiatives for the City.
