MURFREESBORO, Tenn. – In observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day, all City of Murfreesboro offices, most recreational facilities, and St. Clair Street Senior Center, will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2016.

Rover, the City's public transportation service, will not run on the MLK Day federal holiday.

Old Fort and VA Golf Courses will be open. Adams Tennis Complex will be open. MTSU Men's Tennis hosts Vanderbilt at 2:00 p.m.

There will be no garbage pick-up on Monday, January 18, 2016. Monday's garbage pick-up will be Tuesday, January 19, 2016. Tuesday's garbage pick-up will be Wednesday, January 20, 2016.

City business offices will resume their regular hours of operation, which are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Tuesday, Jan. 19.

On Monday, the **2016 Annual Martin Luther King Jr. Day March** will travel down East Main Street to Patterson Park Community Center, 521 Mercury Blvd. Walkers will begin assembling at Central Magnet School, 701 E. Main St., around 11:30 a.m. and the march will begin at 12:00 noon.

Also Monday, the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship Fund of Rutherford County will sponsor an **MLK Jr. Celebration** at Patterson Park Community Center at 1 p.m., including dance, poetry, and music.

From 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the KUC Theater on the MTSU campus, members of the MTSU community will hold an **MLK celebration and candlelight vigil** to highlight the contributions made by King and his wife, Coretta Scott King.
