Spring chickens and Murfree Spring featured in March 'Adventures in Murphry's Burrow'

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. – Spring is about to spring and so is the meaning of the word on "Adventures in Murphry's Burrow." MTSU instructor of agriculture Alanna Vaught and Karyn Knecht of the Discovery Center are the featured guests in the newest edition of "Adventures in Murphry's Burrow" on CityTV. Murph talks with Vaught and her son, J.B. about raising chickens. As Murph says, "It's something to get "egg-cited" about.

Murph also visits the Discovery Center to talk with Karyn Knecht about underground springs and aquifers like the one that springs water from underneath the Discovery Center. Vaught is an instructor in the MTSU School of Agribusiness and Agriscience. Knecht is camp coordinator at the Discovery Center http://explorethedc.org/.

This month's show features:

- The 21-day cycle of how baby chicks are born; either under a hen or a heat lamp.
- Learn what the four letters in 4-H represent.
- Learn about multi-meaning words such as the word "spring."
- Visit the natural Murfree Spring at the Discovery Center to learn about springs and aquifers as well as the lily pad used to teach children and adults about plants and animals that live under water.
- Watch Karen Knecht test water for Ph to see whether it has the proper alkaline.
- And join Murph in making a spring with a paper clip and a coil with construction paper.
