MURFREESBORO, Tenn. — The Murfreesboro City Council will meet in a special meeting at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, April 21, 2016, in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 111 West Vine Street, Murfreesboro, Tenn., for the purpose of discussing issues relating to the selection and purchase of property for a park on the West side of Murfreesboro.

What: The Council will gather to discuss issues related to a West Park.

Since January the City, Parks and Recreation Department, and City Council have been engaged in a process of identifying and reviewing potential parcels of land. On January 14, 2016, Council received an update from David Coode, planning consultant Kimley-Horn & Associates. Parks Director Lanny Goodwin has previously indicated that the City of Murfreesboro is short of recreational fields, including soccer, baseball and softball fields, according to National Recreation and Parks Association standards.
