Adams Tennis Complex will be open from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday.

There will be no garbage pick-up on Monday, Sept. 5. Monday's garbage pick-up will be Tuesday, Sept. 6, and Tuesday's garbage pick-up will be Wednesday, Sept. 7.

Labor Day is annually held on the first Monday of September. The first Labor Day was held in 1882. Its origins stem from the desire of the Central Labor Union to create a holiday for workers. It became a federal holiday in 1894.
