

## Barfield Back Country Campground

### Rental Information

Barfield-Crescent Park houses a beautiful walk-in campground within the park. It is linked to the paved and unpaved trail system beginning at the Wilderness Station and is located approximately one mile hike from the parking lot. The campground is meant to be used as a beginning backpacking, family/group- friendly facility.



#### Amenities:

- Picnic tables
- Garbage receptacles
- Central fire pit
- Vault toilet
- Lantern holders

#### Family Campouts



At least two staff-led Family Campouts take place here each year. A campfire dinner and breakfast is provided, along with night hikes, and live music. More information and dates can be found in the spring and fall editions of the [Rec Connect](#).

## **Group Camping**

Approved groups such as scouts, church youth groups, and college organized clubs are allowed to camp without a staff member. To qualify as an approved group, a Wilderness Awareness workshop and a leader's orientation must be completed.

Things to consider:

- Walk in only, must carry all of your gear in on a paved trail, approximately 1 mile
- No potable water available at campground
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited
- Maximum length of stay is 2 days
- Camping available on Fridays and Saturdays only
- All campers must complete a free Wilderness Awareness Workshop prior to camping

## **Booking**

- Camping offered April – November (restroom facilities will be winterized during the cold months)
- Camping available on Fridays and Saturdays only
- A minimum of 10 campers or \$50.00
- Must check in at the Wilderness Station by closing – unless otherwise approved
- Must reserve campsite(s) 1 week in advance
- The Wilderness Station staff has the right to cancel a reservation due to inclement weather
- Educational and interpretive programs can be added for an additional fee and must be set up prior to the arrival of campers
- All participants will have to sign a waiver prior to camping
- All participants ages 6 and older will have to complete a **Wilderness Awareness Workshop** and in addition all leaders will have to complete a **Leader's Orientation** (minimum of 2 adults, 18 years or older) – both of these are free of charge
- Groups camping with kids must have a 5 : 1 ratio of minors : adults

Family Campouts	\$10/adult \$5/child (includes equipment rental, dinner, and breakfast)
Leave No Trace Class	Free

## **Equipment Rental Costs**

2-man tent (includes ground cloth)	\$8/day
4-man tent (includes ground cloth)	\$12/day
Ground Cloth	\$1/day
Backpack (adult)	\$4/day
Backpack (child)	\$2/day
Sleeping Pad	\$1/day
Hammock	\$5/day
