COMMERCIAL DEMOLITION PERMITS INFORMATION

Contractor/responsible party must permit. (The Permit fee is based on ½ of demolition cost and is calculated using the building permit fee schedule).

Contractors must provide a current State of Tennessee Contractor's License and a Certificate of Insurance for Workers' Compensation coverage listing the City of Murfreesboro as the certificate holder.

3. Possible Land Disturbance Issue – City of Murfreesboro Engineering Department

Demolition permit will require a letter from the contractor/responsible party regarding material disposal. The letter must give the following information:

1. How the debris is to be removed; by truck, dumpster (dumpster provider's name) etc.
2. Name and location of approved landfill.
3. Haul sites other than approved landfills will require local governmental agency approval of the dump site in writing.
4. List any material(s) to be recycled and where it is being taken.
5. If reusing/recycling material in a building project the location of the project and written approval from the local governmental agency or a copy of the building permit stating recycled material is being used.
